- Format: One-day competition, consisting of five (5)
 games qualifying followed by top 5 in single game
 elimination step ladder for scholarship tournament.
 Junior Gold advancers are determined after the 5
 games of qualifying
- Three (3) divisions based on ability, not gender or age
- \$80 entry fee covers scholarship competition (SSJBA divisions) \$20
 Jr. Gold sweeper (Jr. Gold Divisions) \$27
 Lineage: \$25; Super Bowl fund \$5
